Objective: The students will demonstrate the meaning of addition through manipulating beans or blocks.

Materials: blocks or beans

Procedure:

- 1) Play the song.
- 2) Show students how to combine/add 1-digit numbers using small blocks.
- 3) Start with 1 block, and then add one more each time, following along with the song.
- 4) Write the numbers 2, 3 and 4 on the board and ask students to add sequential numbers to each of the numbers up to +15.

Evaluation: Teacher observations as the students add chronological numbers to each starting number. Extension activity: Students roll a pair of dice, place 2 sets of beans on their work mat that represent the numbers on the dice, and then write the addition number sentence on the work mat. Repeat 7 additional times.
