

# Comparison Chart


Use a Comparison Chart to identify similarities and differences. A Comparison Chart focuses on comparisons. As part of the process of comparing, however, contrasts are identified as well.

As students finish listing items that are being compared, they can draw a line across their charts to create a row and move onto the next item being compared.

If you would like for students to use three criteria for comparing items, use Comparison Chart for 3; if you would like them to use four criteria, use the chart for 4, and so forth.
