Lyndon Johnson

2. This woman was arrested for not giving up her seat in the white section of a Montgomery bus. To support her, African Americans in Montgomery boycotted the buses. A year later the Supreme Court ordered Montgomery to end segregation on its buses.



Martin Luther King, Jr.

3. This man called for a peaceful march on Washington, D.C. Its great success drew national attention to the civil rights movement, and the movement continued to grow across the nation.



Rosa Parks

4. This man worked hard to convince Congress to pass the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and the Voting Rights Act of 1965. These acts helped African Americans get elected to government offices.
