Directions for Installing My Math Zone

1. Insert the My Math Zone CD into the computer CD drive and *wait*.
2. The My Math Zone CD window will appear, showing the My Math Zone Folder.
3. Copy and paste, or drag and drop, the *entire* My Math Zone Folder to anywhere on the computer.
4. After copying is complete, remove the My Math Zone CD from the computer.

Directions for Using My Math Zone

Double-click the My Math Zone icon (inside the My Math Zone Folder) to launch My Math Zone.
Or, double-click the Toolkit icon (inside the My Math Zone Folder) to launch the Toolkit.

My Math Zone Toolkit Files

The Toolkit and Engine will create a "My Math Zone Toolkit Files" folder on the root directory of the system drive (default location). This folder is used to store Bonus Questions, Resources, and Presets created by teachers using the Toolkit. Therefore, the teacher must have read and write privileges for this folder and all folders and files within.

Generally the default location is suitable. However, if it is necessary that this folder be created in a different location, open the Path.TXT file in Notepad or TextEdit, type a valid path, save as a text file, and close.

If you need to reset the "My Math Zone Toolkit Files" folder to the default location on the root directory of the system drive, open the Path.TXT file, delete all characters, including spaces and returns, and save and close the file.

Changing the location of this file does not transfer any Bonus Questions, Resources, or Presets that may have been created by the teacher.
